NEW PRODUCTS

9023 Power Supply

The 9023 is designed for a military application where continuous operation is critical. This power supply provides +5V @ 158A, +12V @ 14A, and -12V @ 7A with N+1 redundancy, input power factor correction and battery backup for 50 seconds. The power supply has four power modules and will provide full power output with any three modules. A control



module provides output monitoring, battery charging, and system interface for power supply status. The power supply is a 3U high, 19-in. rack mount design.

Schedule was a critical item to our customer. We were able to deliver the first form-fit-function power supply in just 13 weeks. Although this is not our preferred schedule, we will support our customer's critical needs when required.
